Basic Membership: Minimum of \$20

Sponsorship Levels

Patriot Level: \$120 or \$30 paid quarterly

Minuteman Level: \$240 or \$60 paid quarterly

Sons of Liberty Level: \$480 or \$120 paid quarterly

Fine Print:

1. All memberships are for the calendar year and expire on December 31, regardless of when purchased or renewed. (EXCEPTION: New memberships purchased in December will be held over for the following year.)
2. If a sponsorship is purchased on the quarterly installment plan after March 31, quarterly payments for previous calendar quarters will be billed along with the current quarter.
3. Quarterly payments will be billed on April 1, July 1, and October 1. If a quarterly payment is returned or declined, that payment will be re-billed on the 1st of each month in the quarter until paid. If at the end of that quarter, the payment has not been made successfully, the sponsorship will drop to the nearest membership/sponsorship level for the funds received. (e.g., someone joins at the Patriot Sponsorship level and their first quarterly installment is never made, their membership will revert to a Basic membership because \$30 has been collected.)
4. Sponsorship benefits are as follows:
 - a. Patriot: Members of this level will receive an invitation to an annual luncheon with the Director and Deputy Directors of OK2A in which strategy for the organization and legislative agenda will be discussed. Members will be responsible for the cost of their meal.
 - b. Minuteman: Members of this level will receive the benefits of the Patriot level, plus an invitation to a luncheon and round table discussion with legislators and other guests to discuss the state of Oklahoma's gun laws and strategy to strengthen our state's gun laws. Members will be responsible for the cost of their meal.
 - c. Sons of Liberty: Members of this level will receive all the benefits of the Patriot and Minuteman levels, plus they will receive invitations to a free luncheon or reception with any keynote speakers at OK2A fundraising events, including a free picture of them with the speaker.

2012 OK2A Legislative Agenda

OK2A pledges to never compromise in the effort to restore our Second Amendment rights at both the state and national levels. The Second Amendment says, "...the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed." OK2A's legislative agenda is designed to bring Oklahoma's gun laws back to where our Founding Fathers intended by incrementally restoring the Second Amendment while also seeking to pass major reform legislation to fix what our state legislature has broken.

Open Carry

Forty-three other states have some form of Open Carry, including liberal bastions such as Massachusetts, Washington state, and Oregon. Twenty-four states have unlicensed Open Carry. There is no reason why the reddest state should not have Open Carry.

Vehicle Carry

OK2A will seek to pass legislation recognizing the right of Oklahomans to defend themselves while in their vehicle.

Concealed Carry

OK2A is working to clean up problems with our state's concealed carry law. Areas that need improvement include lowering the OSBI and Sheriff's fees, excluding misdemeanors more than 10 years old from consideration on license applications, and removing some of the prohibited places such as the Capitol from the law.

Other RKBA Bills

OK2A is also working on other RKBA (Right to Keep and Bear Arms) legislation, including cleaning up language in our laws that actually make it illegal to open carry on your private property for purposes of self-defense. We also want to give private schools the freedom to set their own policies pertaining to firearms (it is private property, after all). We will seek to further strengthen Oklahoma's "Make My Day" law by adding those who would enter by deception (e.g., someone comes in your home claiming to work for a utility company). We want to make it specifically illegal for the government to confiscate weapons not being used to commit a crime during a state of emergency. We also will seek to make it illegal for any state, county, or local law enforcement agencies to enforce the Federal Gun Free School Zones Act.
